## **CHAMPAGNE**

- 1. Mercier Brut NV** 27.95  
Clean and fruity. An easy drinking sparkling wine.
- 2. Taittinger Brut Reserve NV** 36.95  
Dry, supple and elegant style. Quite intense ripe fruit; structured, fresh and long. A cut above most non-vintage.
- 3. Veuve Clicquot Vintage Reserve 1996** 55.95  
Decidedly rich and full bodied with a floral bouquet and lightly fruity, biscuity flavour. Balanced and age worthy.
- 4. Cuvée Dom Perignon 1995** 98.95  
Consistently superb, becoming fine and toasty in bouquet with a gentle richness, biscuity and complex in flavour. The very best vintages deserve long cellaring.
- 5. Krug NV** 105.95  
Dry with an elegant, floral, biscuity bouquet but with extraordinary richness, depth and class. Harmonious with tremendous length.
- 6. Louis Roederer, Cristal 1997** 179.95  
Dry, relatively light with more floral notes to the bouquet. Becomes nuttied and honeyed with age. Has a subtle silkiness and lingering finish.

## **CHAMPAGNE MAGNUM**

- 7. Veuve Clicquot Brut NV** 79.95  
Full, fruity style, citrus, quite rich but rounded and balanced with good length of flavour.

## **PINK CHAMPAGNE**

- 8. Heidsieck Monopole Rose NV** 29.95  
Salmon pink with a fine mousse, impressive fruit richness and depth. Well defined.

## **SPARKLING WINE**

- 9. Pelorus, Cloudy Bay, New Zealand** 22.95  
Medium bodied, elegant style of New World sparkler with clean and pure apple and citrus fruit. A touch of subtle bready yeastiness adds complexity.

# **WHITE WINE**

## **FRANCE, ALSACE**

**10. Trimbach Riesling 2003** 19.95  
Dry, very long-lived with remarkably complex, powerful perfume and flavour. Flinty, mineral, petrolly, very long and rich with 15-20 years cellaring potential.

**11. Trimbach Gewürztraminer 2002** 22.95  
Highly aromatic, dry, spicy, elegant style with some grapefruit and floral elements. Balanced and medium bodied; drink fairly young.

## **FRANCE, BURGUNDY**

**12. Chablis Les Manants 2003** 21.95  
Light and dry with flinty, mineral notes, subtle plum fruit, good definition and some complexity with 2 or 3 years of age.

**13. Chablis 1er Cru Domaine Drouhin 2002** 31.95  
This Chablis has a very attractive and intense aroma reminiscent of coriander, orange and lemon. Generous, round and long on the palate, it is also full bodied with refreshing vivacity.

**14. Chassagne Montrachet Domaine Drouhin 1999** 39.95  
Beautifully balanced wine with delicate nuances of pear, vanilla and almond. Round and ample on the palate, the wine has length and complexity.

**15. Puligny-Montrachet Jean Marc Pillot 2002** 45.95  
Elegant, oaky dry white. Well balanced, nutty, creamy, toasty characters. Accessible within 2 or 3 years, but has good staying power.

**16. Meursault Les Vireuils 2003** 47.95  
Renowned for its nutty, buttery fruit, sometimes lusciously peachy, the standard of wine from this producer is always elegant and enticing with layer upon layer of flavour on the finish.

## **FRANCE, LOIRE VALLEY**

**17. Muscadet Le Fief de la Brie Sur Lie 2004** 14.95  
Fruity perfume and slightly earthy taste, dry, well balanced, best at about 1 or 2 years.

**18. Montlouis Sec 2002** 19.95  
Dry and flinty with notes of green apple and minerals. Zesty acidity provides the structure for aging. Good weight and richness for the style.

**19. Sancerre Domaine Daulny 2004** 24.95  
Quite pungent aroma, grassy, asparagus characters, full, round flavour, evolves quite quickly, best drunk young.

**20. Pouilly Fume Serge Dagueneau 2004** 22.95  
Dry, medium to full bodied wine with ripe, forward, almost tropical flavours. Drink within 3 years.

### GERMANY, MOSEL

**21. Schloss Lieser Riesling Kabinett 2001** 24.95  
Light, intensely fruity, off dry with peach and blackcurrant flavours, with piercing acidity and a dry finish.

### ITALY

**22. Pinot Grigio Trentino 2004** 24.95  
Full bodied, concentrated with ripe pear, spice and quince notes. Deep and apple in the mouth with excellent structure and length.

**23. Orvieto Classico Il Palazzone 2002** 21.95  
Deep colour, perfumed with a nutty, biscuity complexity and real richness. Develops well.

### CHILE

**24. Vina Santa Carolina Chardonnay Reserva 2002** 18.95  
Fresh, rich wine brimming with creamy, nutty pineapple flavours and well-integrated oak.

**25. Vina Santa Carolina Sauvignon Blanc Reserva 2004** 18.95  
Richer and fuller than many Chilean Sauvignons, with persistent lime juice flavours. Drink within 1 to 2 years of the vintage.

### USA, CALIFORNIA

**26. Angels Creek Viognier 2003** 19.95  
A richly textured wine with floral, herbal and apricot character.

**27. Saint Francis Chardonnay Sonoma 2002** 24.95  
A big, rich oaky example with a buttery, fleshy texture and ripe, complex flavours.

## AUSTRALIA

**28. Voyager Estate Semillon 2001** 21.95

Fermented in French oak, this wine has clean ripe fruit with delicacy and balance.

**29. Crawford River Sauvignon Blanc 2001** 22.95

Exudes crisp flavours of citrus and stone fruit.

**30. Trentham Estate Chardonnay 2004** 22.95

Ripe peach and fruit flavours are augmented by some vanilla and oak. Moderately high in alcohol with some fruit sweetness and some warmth on the finish.

## NEW ZEALAND

**31. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2004** 39.95

Staggered picking provides an array of flavours from blackcurrant leaf to tropical fruit. Nuanced, finely balanced with pungency of aroma and purity of flavour, and persistence on the palate.

**32. McCorkindale Sauvignon Blanc 2004** 23.95

Zesty, aromatic wine with gooseberry and passion fruit flavours. Drink young.

**33. Isabel Chardonnay 2003** 26.95

Mavellous concentration and depth here. Balanced, complex with a structure that suggests good aging potential.

## SOUTH AFRICA

**34. Niel Joubert Chenin Blanc, Paal 2003** 23.25

Full-throttle ripe tropical fruit; gains weight and richness from small barrel fermented portion. Balanced off-dry style.

**35. Durbanville Hills Sauvignon Blanc 2003** 26.95

Penetrating asparagus and gooseberry scents. Big, bold palate with plentiful juicy fruit, lively acidity. Best from the most recent vintage.

## ARGENTINA

**36. Bodegas Lurton Pinot Gris 2003** 17.95

Spicy and floral aromas with hints of new oak. Medium body, rich, spicy finish.

## ENGLAND

- 37. Three Choirs 2003** 18.95  
Markedly herbaceous style, full bodied and with good length. Pungent, characterful, well structured, dry wine with great finesse. Will keep well.

## PINK WINE

- 38. Waters Edge White Zinfandel** 18.95  
A delicious dry rose with red berry fruit. Medium sweet, simple and clean.

- 39. Sancerre Pinot Rose 2002** 22.95  
Fine salmon-pink colour, dry with floral, red fruit perfume. Medium bodied with delicate flavour and finish.

## RED WINE

### AUSTRALIA

- 40. Mitchell Peppertree Shiraz 2003** 26.95  
Rich, spicy berry and liquorice aromas and flavours are hallmarks of the style underpinned by ripe tannins. Good concentration and weight.

- 41. Mitchell's Grenache 2001** 24.95  
Ripe, sweet, slightly spicy fruit in a medium to full bodied style. Concentrated with ample ripe tannins and good depth and length.

### NEW ZEALAND

- 42. McCorkindale Pinot Noir 2003** 29.95  
Aromatic with strong plum, black cherry, blackberry, liquorice and smoky oak flavours. Supple and elegant; attractive young, but better with a little age.

### SOUTH AFRICA

- 43. Durbanville Hills Pinotage 2001** 24.95  
Oaky, berryish and earthy notes in aroma and flavour. Increasingly round and soft, and attractively fruity.

- 44. Brampton Old Vines 2003** 25.95  
Aromas of blackberries and plums follow through to a richly spiced palate, with chocolate and mocha adding complexity to the long finish.

## USA, CALIFORNIA

**45. Opus One, Napa Valley 1999** 163.50

Fine, complex oak and blackcurrant dominated bouquet with a mineral quality. Powerful, concentrated, and high tannin – delicacy and finesse with age.

**46. Frogs Leap Zinfandel 2000** 29.95

Medium to full bodied with fine spicy dark berried/black cherry fruit. Has depth, richness and firm but even tannins.

**47. Angels Creek Cabernet Franc 2000** 23.95

Complex, spicy, herbal-berry aromas and good depth of spice, plum and earth flavours in a smooth, supple texture. Approachable early, but better with 3 to 4 years age.

**48. Saint Francis Merlot, Sonoma 2001** 26.95

A wine of great power and concentrated plummy-berry fruit which should improve in the bottle over 5 to 8 years.

## CHILE

**49. Concha y Toro Merlot 2003** 25.95

White pepper and chocolate, plenty of rich sweet plum and cherry fruit given structure by a hint of oak. Long and full finish.

**50. Vina Santa Carolina Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2002** 26.95

Deep coloured, dark, dense, intense blackcurrant with hints of mint and eucalyptus. Rich, ripe, pure fruit with firm tannic structure.

## ARGENTINA

**51. Bodegas Lurton Malbec 2004** 23.95

All smoke and preserved black fruit aromas; deep and concentrated with super fruit character. Abundant tannin. Needs 2 to 3 years age.

## LEBANON

**52. Chateau Musar 1998** 31.95

Medium to full-bodied, high in alcohol, develops superb perfume and flavour with 7 to 10 years age – cedar, dried fruits, tobacco, coffee, raisin, chocolate.

## SPAIN

**53. Rioja Vina Salceda Crianza 2001** 22.95  
Dark ruby, pronounced damson fruits with peppery undertones. Dense rich blackberry with well balanced acidity and tannins.

**54. Vega Sicilia, Valbuena 1998** 79.95  
Intensely coloured with complex spicy, oaky and developed aromas. Powerful, full, well rounded and very fine, with complex flavour and length.

## ITALY

**55. Valpolicella Classico 2003** 17.95  
Warm and velvety with refined aromas and fruit character. Stylish and long.

**56. Barolo La Morra, Corino 1997** 49.95  
Modern style Barolo – ripe red fruits, smoke, spice and floral notes. Full, supple – best with 5 to 10 years age.

**57. Tignanello 2000** 59.95  
Fine oak character married to intense small berried fruit. Powerful, stylish and long lived.

**58. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Taverna Nova 2003** 18.95  
Ripe, supple, peppery fruit with good concentration and depth.

**59. Chianti Riserva Cantine di Montalcino 2001** 28.95  
Rich ruby colour with a distinctly fruity nose where cherry merges with vanilla. On the palate there is a good balance between fruit and tannins that creates a long finish.

**60. Crognolo 2001** 31.95  
Tremendous depth and concentration. Complex combination of fresh and conserved red fruit aromas and spice. Fine balance of tannin and acidity with good depth.

## FRANCE, BEAUJOLAIS

**61. Beaujolais Villages Georges Duboeuf 2002** 22.95  
Brilliantly coloured with a penetrating berry fruit perfume and fine fruitiness. Fresh and easy to drink.

**62. Brouilly Georges Duboeuf 2002** 26.95  
Wild strawberry fruit, peppery, full and smooth, with soft tannins and a slight greenness to flavour.

- 63. Chateau de Raousset Morgan 2002** 22.95  
The finest of the 10 Beaujolais Cru, showing more muscle, grainy tannins, with crunchy black cherry fruit and a long finish.

## **BURGUNDY**

- 64. Gevrey-Chambertin Premier Cru Clos du Fontenay 1997** 55.95  
Ripe berry fruit flavours and an earthy, mineral quality. Full and supple but with tannin in good measure, becoming complex and elegant after 5 to ten years.

- 65. Cote de Beaune Villages 2001** 24.95  
Full, rich and concentrated example. Very ripe fruit and new oak, with appreciable tannin and a long powerful finish.

## **FRANCE, BORDEAUX**

### **PAUILLAC**

- 66. Chateau Mouton-Rothschild Premier Cru 1997** 149.95  
Full bodied, of impeccable class and style, classic cedary, cigar-box, cassis fruit becoming much more with age. A little more exotic and opulent than other first growths.

### **SAINT EMILION**

- 67. Chateau de Ferrand Grand Cru 1998** 40.95  
Combines real richness and power with opulence. A big extracted wine with a delicious fruit character and sweet oak.
- 68. Chateau Rose d'Arthus 2001** 19.95  
Round and supple with delicious berry fruit.

### **GRAVES**

- 69. Chateau Haut-Brion Premier Cru 1981** 140.95  
Remarkably complex – smoky, cassis, tobacco and mineral – gains fine elegance and breed as the tremendous depth slowly unfurls.

### **MARGAUX**

- 70. Chateau Palmer 1995** 115.95  
Wonderfully perfumed, plums, black fruits, floral, oak and much more. Superbly flavoured with a rich opulent texture and fine quality tannin. Very harmonious, refined and complete.

## SAINT JULIEN

- 71. Chateau Talbot 1997** 66.95  
Consistent, full in fruit weight and flavour and superbly perfumed. Firmly structured developing great refinement and harmony with age.

## POMEROL

- 72. Chateau Certan de May 2001** 58.95  
The 2001 is almost Médoc-like in its aromas, with cedar and a hint of spice over ripe blackcurrant. Soft, ripe and medium-bodied, it will drink well from now on and for the next decade or so.

## FRANCE, RHONE VALLEY

- 73. Vacqueyras, Domaine le Clos Des Cazaux 1999** 22.95  
Bold inky Vacqueyras from delicious old vines of Syrah displaying great depth, richness and finesse. Rich in spice and mineral notes with good structure and length.

- 74. Gigondas Domaine Grand Romane Cuvee 2001** 25.95  
Characterful, robust, full bodied with earthy, peppery, berried fruit, even leathery and gamy; warm and generous.

- 75. Crozes-Hermitage Domaine Etienne Pochon 2002** 23.95  
Medium bodied with peppery blackcurrant and raspberry fruit and more smoky, meaty complexity with age. A little more tannin and less overtly than St. Joseph.

- 76. Chateauneuf-du-Pape Mont Redon 2001** 26.95  
Full bodied with floral aromas plus leather, cedar, spice, round and well-knit with fine proportions and complexity with cellaring.

## **DESSERT WINE**

- 77. Chateau Suduiraut Premier Cru Sauternes 1990** 89.95  
Very sweet, concentrated and alcoholic, powerfully perfumed, richly flavoured, honeyed plus great finesse and length of flavour.
- 78. Chateau d'Yquem Premier Grand Cru Classe 1991 (half)** 119.95  
Tremendously rich, very honeyed, botrytized, complex bouquet and flavour. Very luscious, deep and supreme elegance.
- 79. Maury Vin Doux Naturele 2002, France** 32.95  
Rich, deep velvety showing some acidity. A fine accompaniment to chocolate desserts.
- 80. Tokaji Aszu 3 Puttonyas, Hungary 1999** 24.95  
Rich, complex, apricotty flavour, sweet and showing some oxidized character. Plenty of acidity. Likely to age well.
- 81. Lang Samling 88, Beerenauslese, Austria 2002** 33.75  
Deep auburn in colour with a profound nose of honey, nuts, flowers, intoxicating in its richness. This is an outstanding dessert wine, a must try.
- 82. Brown Brothers Orange Flora Muscat, Australia 2003** 20.45  
Delightfully light packed with sweet, soft lingering orange tones.
- 83. Campbell's Rutherglen Muscat, Australia** 26.75  
Honeyed, dark, sticky. Rich and complex in flavour, lightly perfumed with a long finish.
